WHITE

- 17 Chenin Blanc, Green Crest, South Africa**
A lively and expressive Chenin Blanc that shows citrus and some notes of tropical fruit.
- 18 Pinot Grigio, Antonio Rubini, delle Venezie, Italy**
Apples, pears, white peach adorned with elderflower.
- 19 Sauvignon Blanc, Santa Rita 8km, Chile (ve)**
Grapefruit, grassy gooseberry and pineapple flavour, crisp and fresh finish.
- 20 Viognier, La Campagne, Pays d'Oc, France**
Plump sun-soaked apricots, gentle blossom breeze.
- 21 Chardonnay Gran Reserva, Luis Felipe Edwards, Chile (ve)**
Lots of toasty, buttery Chardonnay fruit, pineapple, white peach and nectarine.
- 22 Sauvignon Blanc, Dashwood, Marlborough, NZ (ve)**
Wild melons and passion-fruit entangled with ripe gooseberries, luxurious long finish.
- 23 Muscat Natureo (0.5% ABV), Torres, Spain - De-alcoholised**
Green apples, peaches and citrus, bright and refreshing finish.

LIGHT, DELICATE

- 24 Picpoul de Pinet Reserve Mirou, France**
Offering snappy citrus fruit and green apples with a mouth-watering finish.
- 25 Valdeón Verdejo, Rueda, Spain (ve)**
Delicate aromas of fennel and citrus, in the mouth, there's a lively freshness and a rich finish, while the oak is present it does not mask the fruit.
- 26 Gavi, Ca' Bianca, Italy**
Complex and interesting Gavi with a refreshing green fruit flavour, delicate floral twist with a crisp finish.
- 27 Alandra Branco, Esporão, Portugal**
This organic wine produces aromas of white peach and orange zest. It is floral, fragrant and delicate, with an enhancing fresh and fruity flavour.
- 28 Sauvignon Blanc, Cloudy Bay, Marlborough, New Zealand**
Layers of pure striking flavours combining the distinctive grassy aromas and surprising redcurrant spiciness and fresh lemon zest.

FRUIT DRIVEN, RIPE

- 29 Chardonnay, Stonier, Mornington Peninsula, Australia**
A complex and stunning Chardonnay, subtle creamy texture and a powerful structure with a hint of toast, fresh citrus and pears that drives a long finish.
- 30 Albariño, Rías Baixas, Pulpo, Pagos del Rey, Spain (ve)**
Pleasant balance between citrusy refreshment and easy-going apple and apricot flavours it really is quite moreish, with a satisfyingly soft-edged. Pair well with many flavoursome seafood dishes.
- 31 Orvieto Classico Amabile, Bigi, Umbria, Italy**
An interesting medium dry wine, filled with great flavours of elderberries and pineapple, that pairs with almost anything.
- 32 Chardonnay, Couvent des Jacobins, Louis Jadot, Bourgogne, France**
A fantastic premium Burgundy, a vibrant Chardonnay fruit driven (peach, pear and grapefruit), with a lot of elegance, it is structured, pleasant and harmonious long finish.
- 33 Sauvignon Blanc, Vidal, Marlborough, New Zealand**
A great example of a stunning New Zealand wine – Intense aromas of passion fruit and citrus, moving into a tropical fruit flavour, classic Marlborough at its best.

AROMATIC, HERBACEOUS

- 34 Chablis, Lamblin & Fils, France**
A mouth-watering Chablis, lively crisp citrus fruit backbone, mineral tones and a long finish.
- 35 Chablis 1er Cru, Vaillons, William Fevre, France**
Award winning wine with great pedigree, densely packed with youthful grapefruit and pineapple flavours, classic mineral character and just a hint of oak. A superb premier cru!
- 36 Riesling, Bay of Fires, Tasmania, Australia**
Wow! What an elegant and complex wine! Floral nose, rose petals and lime. But then the palate is a mass of citrus and a crisp mineral flavour that finishes both long and soft.
- 37 Roter Veltliner, 'Von Gösing', Soellner, Austria**
Fresh yellow plum and mandarin open up into a lip smacking fresh zingy citrus finish.
- 38 Sancerre, Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot, France (ve)**
Distinctively elegant, crisp and ripe Sauvignon Blanc, classic blackcurrant leaf and gooseberry character and mineral long finish.

RED

- 39 Tempranillo, Ayrum Tinto, Valdepeñas, Spain**
Smooth blackberry and plump plum.
- 40 Merlot, Altoritas Central Valley, Chile (ve)**
Upfront plums, soft and silky.
- 41 Cabernet Sauvignon, Between Thorns, Australia**
Juicy ripe blackcurrants and warming spice.
- 42 Malbec, Rare Vineyards, Pays d'Oc, France**
Super smooth, full and fruity French red, spicy finish.
- 43 Shiraz, Nederburg The Manor, South Africa**
Ripe plums and spiced cherries.
- 44 Pinot Noir Gran Reserva, Luis Felipe Edwards, Chile (ve)**
Bursting with dark plum, red cherry flavour with a complex and long finish complimented with smoky oak characters and a lingering finish.
- 45 Rioja Crianza, Torres Ibéricos, Spain (ve)**
Blackberries rolled in cocoa and nutmeg, a good classic Rioja flavour.

ELEGANT, RICH, JUICY

- 46 Côtes du Rhône-Villages, Plan de Dieu, Ogier, France**
A Grenache and Syrah blend that shows notes of red fruit and soft spice. Well-balanced with silky tannins, with a touch of pepper-spice on the finish.
- 47 Monastrell, Gustavete el Mudo, Spain**
The Monastrell grape often compared to the wines of Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Smooth body, friendly tannins, rich fruit-driven flavour with a smooth medium long finish.
- 48 Chianti Classico, "Poggio Cheto", Tenute Piccini, Italy**
A wonderfully refined nose full of ripe plum and cherry, filled out by tantalizing spicy notes, luscious ripe raspberries, bitter chocolate and toasty oak flavour.
- 49 Cabernet Sauvignon, Kleine Zalze, Stellenbosch, South Africa**
Brimming over with sun-drenched blackcurrants.
- 50 Alandra Tinto Alentejo, Esporão, Portugal (ve)**
Aromas of ripe cherries and chocolate. A soft mouth filling wine.

WARM, RICH, SPICY

- 51 Black Malbec, Los Intocables, San Juan, Argentina (ve)**
Aged using North American bourbon barrel for 12 months, distinctive aromas of red berries, caramel and vanilla. Soft tannins give creaminess, ripe caramelised fruit and a smoky, spicy finish.
- 52 Shiraz, St Hallett Faith, Barossa, Australia**
Dark cherry, hints of chocolate and spice flavour with a soft rich tannins finish.
- 53 Merlot Gran Reserva, Luis Felipe Edwards, Chile (ve)**
A great Chilean wine, packed full of cherry and blackberry flavour, soft ripe tannin finish.
- 54 Grand Malbec, Alpasión, Mendoza, Argentina**
Big, bold and sensational! Concentrated plums, cherries and blackberries, liquorice and plenty of spicy leads into a long rich finish.
- 55 Pinot Noir, Dashwood, Marlborough, New Zealand (ve)**
Medium bodied bright and juicy. Crunchy black and red cherry fruit wrapped with winter spice.

INTENSE, CONCENTRATED

- 56 Valdubón Reserva, Ribera del Duero, Spain (ve)**
A rich ripe red fruit mixed with nuts, spices, toasted liquorice flavours, it is a powerful, joyful, wine and full of ripe tannins. The attack is elegant, with an excellent and intense finish.
- 57 Gran Reserva Carmenere, Santa Rita, Chile**
Deep plum red, pure blackcurrant nose. Concentrated and piercing, black fruit, vanilla, chocolate.
- 58 Amarone della Valpolicella, Bottega, Italy**
Blockbuster! Heavy, Fruity, Huge tones of black berries, morels and lots and lots of spices. Long finish that won't let you off the hook until you take the next sip. Try it!
- 59 Château Lyonnat, Lussac Saint-Émilion, Bordeaux, France**
A delicious example of St-Émilion - 90% Merlot makes way for a full soft plum and brambly cassis flavours.
- 60 Cabernet Sauvignon, The Federalist, Lodi, USA (ve)**
An outstanding and focused wine, with elegant tannins and dark fruit on the palate. Good length to the clear and bright blackberry, black cherry smooth toned finish.

CHAMPAGNE

- 1 **Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial, Champagne (ve)**
A well-known blend of older reserves with young wines to ensure its classic consistency.
- 2 **Mercier Brut, Champagne (ve)**
Fresh fruity aromas and an intense fruity and spontaneous flavour produced from this year's harvest and reserve wines from previous years.
- 3 **Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut, Champagne (ve)**
Reflecting the traditions of the past, this is full, yet dry and has a rich, creamy style.
- 4 **Ruinart Blanc de Blanc NV, Champagne (ve)**
An excellent Blanc de Blancs from Ruinart. This is a fruity, seductive Champagne with citrusy, floral aromas and stone fruits on the palate.
- 5 **Dom Pérignon Brut, Champagne (ve)**
Long and satisfying, complex, luxury Grand Cru Champagne made only in the best years.
- 6 **Krug Grande Cuvée Brut, Champagne (ve)**
The king of Champagnes - Barrel-fermented to produce this magnificent wine.
- 7 **Moët & Chandon Rosé Impérial, Champagne (ve)**
Intense and lavish rosé with a raspberry, strawberry and summer berry flavour.
- 8 **Mercier Brut Rosé, Champagne (ve)**
Fresh and lively dry rosé Champagne, loads of flavour and balance with flavours of tangy strawberries.

- 12 **Louis Pommery Sparkling Wine, Winchester, Hampshire, England**
The first Champagne house to launch an English sparkling wine! Fresh, crisp and dry palate, with English Cox apples and a honey finish.
- 13 **Codorníu Zero, Alcohol Free Sparkling, Spain**

An interesting medium dry wine, filled with great flavours of elderberries and pineapple, that pairs with almost anything.
- 30 **Albariño, Rías Baixas, Pulpo, Pagos del Rey, Spain**
Pleasant balance between citrusy refreshment and easy-going apple and apricot - quite moreish, with a satisfyingly soft-edged. Pair well with many flavoursome seafood dishes.

- 58 **Amarone della Valpolicella, Bottega, Italy**
